### News from Sacramento...

BSIS has a Chief Governor Schwarzenegger has appointed Paul Johnson as the new Chief of the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services. The following excerpt is from the July 12 press-release announcement.

"Paul Johnson, 54, of Sacramento, has been appointed chief of the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services at the Department of Consumer Affairs. He has served with the California Department of Justice for nearly 30 years. Johnson is currently an administrator with the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information's Applicant Processing Program. He is a committee member on the FBI's National Identification Services, Subcommittee, and the Integrated Automated Fingerprint ID Task Force. This position requires Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$92,302. "Mr. Johnson is a Republican."
